The Desbarats to Echo Bay Planning Board, at the request of the Townships of Johnson, Tarbutt, Laird and Macdonald, Meredith and Aberdeen Additional, has initiated a work program to prepare an Official Plan for the four municipalities that make up the Desbarats to Echo Bay Planning Board. An Official Plan is a policy document the municipalities and the Planning Board that establishes policies for the use and management of land. The new Plan will be prepared to reflect current Provincial planning requirements, environmental features as well as policies that support future opportunities for economic growth and development in the area.
