LANDFILL IDENTIFICATION CARDS

New Landfill Identification Cards will be sent out with this year's final tax bills. The new cards will be blue and each household will receive 2. There will be a transition/education period and by September 1, 2020 everyone should be using their new card at the landfill. The purpose of these cards is to confirm that you own property or are a tenant in our township and are permitted to dispose of waste and enter our landfill.
