TUIRA AND WELLER BRIDGES UPDATE

NAC is putting the final touches on the new culverts that are replacing the Tuira and Weller Bridges which will allow two lanes of traffic to traverse on Watson Rd. As of October 11 Watson Rd. will be open back up for traffic. We would like to thank everyone for their patience during this construction period. This improvement puts the township in a very good position in regard to replacing our infrastructure. We now have 4 bridges left, Muddy Creek, Echo River, Jarrell, Bar River (which we share with Laird). The Ritter Bridge was replaced in 2015 after the 2013 flood and has a minimum of a 50 year life span. Bridges are mandated to be inspected every 2nd year to ensure safety. We have Tulloch Engineering do our inspections and we are in compliance with the regulation.
