PROVINCIAL LOCKDOWN

December 26, 2020-January 9, 2021

On December 21, 2020 Premier Ford made an announcement that beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Boxing Day, December 26, 2020 the Province of Ontario will be on Lockdown. This Lockdown will be from December 26, 2020 until Saturday January 9, 2021.

What this means is Ontarians should stay home to the fullest extent possible. Trips outside of the home should be limited and for essential purposes only (accessing health care and medication, grocery shopping, child care and exercise alone or with people in your household (the people you live with) and in the community where you live, walking pets when required and supporting vulnerable community members to meet the needs above).

Indoor organized public events and social gatherings are not permitted except with members of the same household. (people you live with). Continue to maintain 2 meters of physical distancing from everyone outside of your household, wear a face covering indoors and outdoors if physical distancing cannot be maintained. Face coverings should be tightly fitted to cover the nose, mouth and chin. Scarves and bandanas are insufficient.
