Fire Chief Jarrell and the Echo Bay and Area Volunteer Fire Department would like to remind everyone to please keep the area in front of your gas exhaust & meters clear of snow. Ensure that your 911 signs are secure and visible in case of an emergency. A home evacuation plan is imperative and you need to practice it with your family to ensure everyone knows what to do in the event of an emergency. Check your chimney and pipes and make sure they are clean. In Echo Bay please ensure that you park at least 10' away from a fire hydrant. In an emergency situation firefighters need quick access to these hydrants. Reminder that smoke/carbon monoxide detectors are mandatory in all homes. Please remember to check your batteries twice a year to ensure they are functioning properly. Due to the Pandemic all Echo Bay Volunteer Fire Fighters Association Fundraising Events had to be cancelled. We want to thank everyone for their support in the past and look forward to once again hosting the Pancake Breakfast, Ham & Bean Supper etc. once it is safe to do so.
