Paper towels and facial tissues also do not belong in the toilet because they do not break down like toilet paper does. If these items are flushed they can cause blockages in pipes which may lead to sewage overflows in your home or business. They can also clog sewers and cause costly damages to local wastewater infrastructure.
