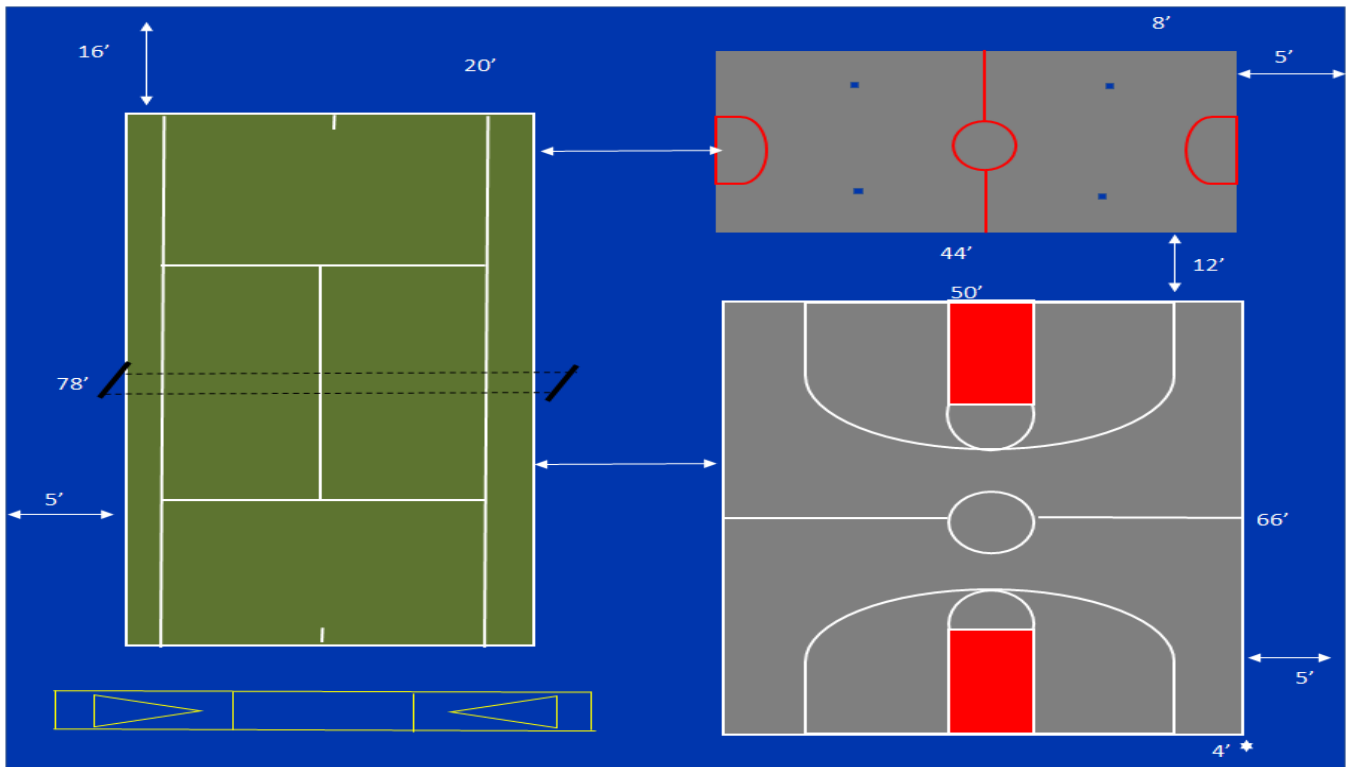

COVID-19 SECOND DOSE VACCINATIONS

As of June 21, 2021 anyone who received their first dose vaccination on May 9, 2021 or earlier can now book their second dose vaccination. You will receive an e-mail or phone call from Algoma Public Health depending on how you booked your first dose. Anyone who has not received their first dose can also book an appointment through the Algoma Public Health Website. Children ages 12-17 can book their first dose through Algoma Public Health by calling 705-541-7370 or going to their website. In order to continue with the Province's 3 Step Re-Opening Ontario Plan we must have 70-80% of Adults who have received one dose and 25% who have received 2nd dose to move to STEP 3. Let's continue to move forward with this battle against the COVID-19 Pandemic in order to get back to some sort of normality in everyone's lives. We thank everyone in our community for doing their part but we need to continue to wear masks and physical distance until we are confident that the majority of our population has received their vaccinations. We hope everyone can enjoy their summer and our children can go back to school in the fall.

ICIP-INVESTING IN CANADA INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM: COVID-19 RESILIENCE INFRASTRUCTURE STREAM

We have been approved for \$99, 636.83 in funding, Federal Contribution-\$79,709.46 and Provincial Contribution-\$19,927.37, for the Rehabilitation of the Hurley Park Tennis Courts under the ICIP Program. This will include a new concrete pad, Sport Court installed on top of the pad, tennis net, basketball nets, shuffle board, ball hockey, and pickle ball. Construction will begin soon with the removal of the fencing, which we will be doing ourselves, and removal of the existing asphalt and site preparation which is also being done in house. Later this summer the concrete pad will be poured and the Sport Court installed on top. We would like to ask everyone to please use caution in this area once the construction has started and to be patient, we think you will be very happy once this project is completed.



MUNICIPAL SERVICES

With the Stay At Home Order being lifted the Municipal Office will remain locked but we are open and you can come in by appointment. Only one person can come in the office at a time (unless you are from the same household) and you will have to sign in and wear a mask. We continue to encourage people to be vaccinated and reach the goals set by the Province to continue the Reopening Ontario Plan.
