REOPENING ONTARIO-STEP 3

We are currently in Step 3 on the Roadmap to Reopen Ontario. In order to safely exit Step 3 70-80% of Adults must be vaccinated with one dose and 25% must be fully vaccinated with two doses. At this point in time the Algoma District has 82% of residents aged 12 and over have received their first dose and 73.5% having received their second dose. Now we just need the rest of the Province to reach this milestone in order to exit Step 3. Algoma Public Health would like to make everyone aware that all clinics scheduled for the month of August at the GFL Memorial Gardens will be welcoming walk-ins, in addition to scheduled appointments for first or second doses. Please ensure that your second dose is 28 days after you received your first dose. They would also like to make everyone aware that there will be upcoming pop up clinics held:
