JOB OPPORTUNITY - ROAD SUPERINTENDENT

The Road Superintendent is responsible for the management of all operations and employees under the Public Works Department. This includes road and bridge maintenance, winter operations, supervisory and safety components, fleet management, public works and municipal landfill. The Road Superintendent is required to be on call and will work extended hours as required.

Minimum Qualifications

- Minimum one year college diploma in related field;
- Minimum 3 years roads experience;
- Minimum 2 years supervisory experience with the ability to effectively lead and supervise staff;
- Valid DZ License with clean drivers abstract;
- Preferred Roads Supervisor Certification-Ontario Good Roads or certification in related courses such as supervision/construction;
- Thorough knowledge and experience of road maintenance and construction and related equipment including plow truck with wing and sander, grader, backhoe, steam jenny, boemeg roller, tractor, and general shop tools
- Experience and proficiency in mechanical and technical skills and equipment
- A demonstrated management/supervisory ability with strong communication, organizational and leadership/interpersonal skills
- Understanding of the Provincial Legislation related to roads construction and maintenance, in particular Ontario Minimum Maintenance Standards, Municipal By-laws and Policies
- Proficient computer experience to complete reports/budget
