### **MUNICIPAL ELECTION 2022 - NOMINATION DAY**

Friday August 19 is Nomination Day, which is the final day that you can file Nomination Papers for the 2022 Municipal Election. Any person planning to seek office in the 2022 Municipal election can file Nomination Papers with the Clerk or designate at 208 Church St. between the hours of 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Monday to Thursday this week. On Nomination Day, Friday August 19<sup>th</sup> you can file papers between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. only. To file for Head of Council (Mayor-1 position) you will require a nomination fee of \$200.00 and to file for Councillor (4 positions) you will require a nomination fee of \$100.00. All completed and filed forms are public documents.

The Municipal Election will be held on Monday October 24<sup>th</sup> at the Echo Bay Hall. Advance Polls will be held on Saturday October 15<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday October 19<sup>th</sup> at the Echo Bay Hall.

Please visit voterlookup.ca to ensure that you are on the Voters List for the upcoming Municipal Election on Monday October 24, 2022.

If you find that you are not on the List of Electors you can have your name added. Please ensure that you have either the address of where you are living or the Assessment Roll # of your property. You will also need to answer questions regarding school board support in order to determine which School Board Trustee you will be voting for. It is a relatively simple process but for some reason if you require assistance or you do not have access to a computer you can contact the municipal office at 705-248-2441.
