FIRE PERMITS

Fire Permits are required from April 1-October 31 for all Open Air Burning. You can obtain a permit by coming into the municipal office, or online at echobay.ca Fire Permits are \$5.00. You can burn 2 hours before sunset until 2 hours after sunrise. Do not burn during windy conditions.

STREET SWEEPING

POT HOLES/LOAD RESTRICTIONS

These will remain in place until the Road Super deems all the frost is out and restrictions can be lifted. This normally happens after the long weekend in May depending on how the spring goes.

DOG TAGS

If you have not purchased your dog license/tag by March 31 it will now be doubled in price. You can get your license online at echobay.ca or by coming into the municipal office. Licenses are now \$10.00 if your dog is spayed or neutered and \$30.00 if they are not. We would like to request that everyone be courteous dog owners. Do not let your dogs run at large, please pick up after your dog if not on your own property and have your dog leashed and under control when walking.
