Job Description

The Facilities Operator/Parks & Recreation employee is the lead staff person responsible for arena Operations in the winter months, grass cutting in the summer months and over all recreational maintenance year-round. The Facilities Operator/Parks and Rec employee is also responsible for providing back-up to the landfill and roads departments. The Facilities Operator/Parks & Recreation employee works under the direction of the Leisure Services Coordinator/Road Superintendent.

Qualifications

- Secondary School Diploma or equivalent.
- One-year related experience in the operation and maintenance of recreational facilities preferred.
- Class “G” license, with clean driving record. Class “DZ” license considered an asset.
- Knowledge and ability to operate and maintain various pieces of equipment as required, e.g. ice making equipment, Zamboni, tractors, lawn mower, weed eater, plow truck, backhoe, steamer, roller, etc.
- Demonstrated mechanical ability inclusive of ability to use small tools to repair washrooms, doors, gates, etc. and repair various items as required.
- General knowledge of road maintenance.
- Organization, time management, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Must be physically able to perform the work, including but not limited to:
 - Use hands to operate objects, tools, and reach with hands and arms.
 - Stand, walk, sit, climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, and crawl.
 - Repetitive bending/lifting (heavy)
