The Township of Macdonald, Meredith & Aberdeen Additional is asking all water users to limit water use from

August 12-16, 2024

We will be reducing the level of water in our Water Tower to complete fall arrest and safety upgrades. During this time, we ask that residents limit their water use as we will be operating out of our reservoir at the Water Treatment Plant during this time.

Broadband Internet Partnership Announced

A \$97 Million Investment Announced to connect 18,600 Northern Ontario homes to high speed Internet.

On June 24, 2024 an announcement was made about a partnership between the federal and Ontario governments expecting to connect 18,600 homes from Manitoulin Island all along the North Shore to high speed internet by the end of 2025. The funding is going to a company called ROCK Networks Inc. to design and build the network which could be shovel ready as early as fall 2024 in our area. More information on this long-awaited project will be provided as it becomes available!
