ANNUAL HYDRANT FLUSHING & VALVE EXERCISING

Ontario Clean Water Agency will be doing our annual hydrant flushing and valve exercising on May 19-23, 2025. Residents may experience short periods of lower than normal water pressure and some discolored water. This annual maintenance is necessary to keep our system functioning to its full capacity.

BE CAREFUL WHAT YOU FLUSH

We would like to remind everyone not to flush disinfectant wipes, baby wipes etc. Despite what some packaging says, wipes are NOT flushable. Paper towels and facial tissues also do not belong in the toilet because they do not break down like toilet paper does. If these items are flushed, they can cause blockages in your pipes which may lead to sewage overflows in your home or business. They can also clog sewers and cause costly damages to local wastewater infrastructure.

REMEMBER THE 3 "P"'s that are flushable. PEE, POOP and PAPER (toilet paper) NO EXCEPTIONS!
