Nomination papers must be filed in person with the Clerk or designate. Candidates are encouraged to contact the Clerk in advance to review forms and schedule an appointment.

The Township will be using online voting for the 2026 Municipal Election. Eligible voters will be able to cast their ballot from anywhere during the voting period. Additional details, including voting dates and instructions, will be provided in the coming months.

To ensure you are ready to vote, please take a moment to confirm or update your information on the Voters List. This will ensure you receive your Voter Information Letter with your voting details.

A Vote Help Centre will be available at the Municipal Office during the voting period for those who require assistance. Staff will be available to help guide voters through the process.
